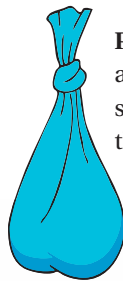

Poop pick-up bags – all responsible owners should carry bags for the inevitable.



Dog Treat Bag – a simple bag with compartments to store training treats, mobile phone, keys and poop bags is an essential for a fun trip to the park.



Leash – essential to the trip to the dog park and back. Having a leash on your dog shows that you're responsible and ensures that your dog is under control. Essential for high density areas or if distractions like a cat or another dog may make you lose control.

Treats – great for readjusting your dog's priorities. Small treats are the best – dried liver is an all-time favourite as it's easy to break up but chicken is good too.



Portable water bowl light-weight and easy to pack into a training bag, these bowls are ideal.



Collar with ID Tag – a collar with a tag with basic contact info means that if you become separated, your dog will probably find her way back to you more quickly.

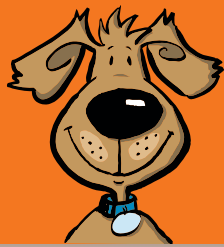


Water – if not available – not all dog parks have a source of water. All dogs are prone to dehydration all year round.



Comfy walking shoes (for you) – be blister free and invest in a good pair of walking shoes that keep feet cushioned and keep out sharp sticks.
